BOARDING DAY TIPS

Staterooms. Staterooms will be ready for occupancy at approximately 1:00 pm. Until then, we invite you to explore the ship.

Luggage. All luggage will be delivered directly to your stateroom. If your luggage has not arrived by 8:00 pm, please contact Guest Services, Deck 5.

SeaPass.® Your SeaPass® card is your onboard charge card. This card also identifies you when you enter and exit the ship.

Main Dining Room. Your main dining room table assignment is printed on the front of your SeaPass® card. Our Maitre'D will be available for any table or seating change requests between 11:30 am - 3:45 pm today in the Romeo & Juliet Dining Room, Deck 4.

My Time Dining. Enjoy the flexibility to dine whenever you want from day to day. To take advantage of the My Time Dining program, register by Day 2. Visit the Main Dining Room, Deck 5 between 11:00 am - 6:00 pm or dial 4632 to register.

Gratuities. A \$12.00 USD gratuity, \$14.25 USD for suite guests, will be automatically added to each guest's SeaPass® account on a daily basis. Guests who prepaid their gratuity prior to boarding will not have a daily gratuity charged to their SeaPass® card.

Guest Assembly Drill. Prior to sailing, a mandatory emergency drill will be conducted. This will help you familiarize yourself with the safety routine and your assigned assembly station in the event of an emergency. Listen to announcements for further instruction and watch the safety film on your stateroom television, channel 14.

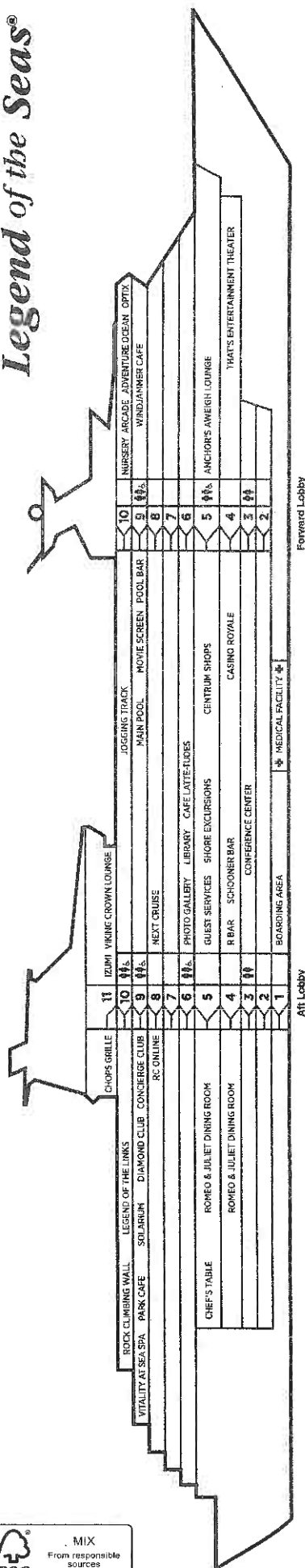

Youth Evacuation Program (YEP). Upon boarding, all children under 12 years of age are given colored wristbands corresponding to their emergency assembly station. In the event of an emergency, the Adventure Ocean Staff will escort all children participating in Adventure Ocean activities to their assigned assembly stations. The wristband system will also allow the crew to direct any child to the appropriate assembly station, even if they are not participating in Adventure Ocean.

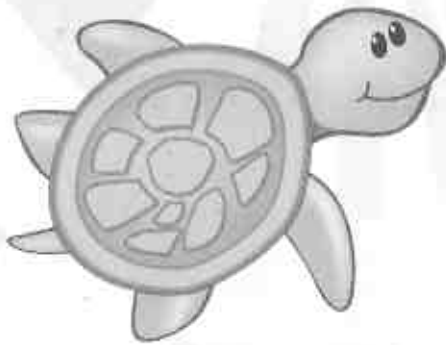

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

What Must I Bring With My Child?

The Nursery will stock a small supply of essential childcare items, however parents are required to provide any personal items their child may need during their stay. This may include diapers, wipes, bottles and milk, food or snacks, sippy cups, extra set of clothes and personal comfort items. Please note: the Royal Babies and Tots Nursery cannot hold any fresh food for longer than four hours.

Can I Get Off the Ship?

Parents are welcome to leave the ship while their child is being cared for in the Nursery. We can take cellular phone numbers at a parents' request, but cannot guarantee we will be able to get hold of parents should we need to. Please check any shore excursions that match with the Nursery opening hours. If the times does not match your excursion, please let us know and we will accomodate your request.

Royal Babies and Tots Cancellation Policy

We require 1 hour notice to cancel a reservation. A fee of 50% will be charged if less than 1 hour notice is given prior to the scheduled session.

Royal Babies and Tots Child Behavior Policy

Behavior deemed inappropriate by Royal Babies and Tots will not be permitted within the facilities. We require complete family cooperation, and many dismiss any child from activities if behavior continues to be inappropriate after continued communication with the family.

Late Pick Up Policy

Guest will be charged \$1 late fee each minute late per child, starting at minute 16. Guests will not be charged if a shipboard activity or shipboard purchased shore excursion runs late. We thank you for your cooperation.

Infant Evacuation Plan

In the unlikely event of an emergency, do not go to the Royal Babies and Tots Nursery as your child(ren) will already be in route to their assembly station. The Nursery staff will deliver your child(ren) and meet you at your muster station.

Royal Tots Adventure Art

Art materials build children's creativity, independence, and confidence through hands-on exploration. Toddler recommended and supervision required.

Open Play

An open session for babies and tots to play with their families is available. This is an unhosted activity and parental supervision is required.

Play Group

A hosted activity for babies and tots to share time with their family. Sing-a-long, play some games and meet new friends. Parental supervision is required.

Royal Bedtime Stories

Missing that bedtime routine? We invite the whole family to enjoy a bedtime story and lullabies. Children are encouraged to dress in their pajamas, while an Adventure Ocean Staff reads from one among a variety of storybooks.

Toy Lending

Couldn't fit all the toys you wanted for your little one? Be sure to check out our Toy Lending Program which comprises of a collection of developmental toys specifically created for infants and toddlers, ages 6-36 months. Parents can borrow and exchange toys for a new activity every day to help growing minds learn through play.

Sitters at Sea

Need a baby-sitter? Speak to the Guest Services Staff at the Guest Relations Desk, Deck 5 for information on our In-Stateroom baby-sitting service. Children must be 1 year old. A service fee applies. Please note that there is a limited number of baby-sitters available.

PLAY TIPS

DON'T MISS OUT!

Take advantage of the opportunity to play and have fun with your child(ren). This is an opportunity you won't want to miss!

OBSERVE YOUR CHILD AT PLAY

Observation provides hints to the next stage of development. Follow your child's cues: be creative and resourceful when playing with your child. Allow enough time for play. Children need large blocks of time to play; they learn best in an environment which allows them time to explore, discover and play!

PLAYGROUPS

Getting together with other youngsters and parents can be the highlight of your cruise. Your baby is likely to be fascinated by a change of environment and the presence of people their own size. They might just get to try out a new toy (or three). Plus, grab some much needed social time; and no one understands your new-parent feelings better than those in the same boat- or shall we say ship!

BABIES AND TOTS

When you combine with babies and tots who are accustomed to starring in their own solo shows, you are likely to experience some "drama" queen moments, including sharing spats, bites and hitting. While it is disturbing to watch your baby act up, rest assured that you are not raising a bite-sized bully. The fact is it is simply too early for your child to understand that their little playmate (and his/her parent) have feelings that can be hurt. After all, they are just starting to learn what it means to be a friend.

HANDLING PLAYGROUP MELTDOWNS WITH GRACE

HITTING, BITING AND OTHER DISPLAYS OF AGGRESSION

Be calm and gentle, yet also swift and firm in your response. This means you need to supervise playtime so that you can prevent problems or react to them quickly. Remove your baby from the area and explain to your child that hitting hurts, or that teeth are for biting food, not friends. Your child may not understand what you are saying yet, but the lesson will be repeated in the months to come.

GRABBING TOYS-REFUSING TO SHARE

It will be another year or two before your baby will grasp the concept of sharing and taking turns. So for now if they steal a toy from their buddy, try to replace it with a toy they can use together (such as blocks or stacking cups). You can try removing the offending toy from your baby's grasp and explain that their friend hasn't finished their turn. Don't expect this message to sink in immediately, again this will be repeated in months to come. If your baby is extremely fussy don't be afraid to end the session early. He or she may be tired, hungry, over stimulated or just not feeling social today. Cut your losses and try another session.

TAMING TANTRUMS WITH FUN!

Here are five great ways to "de-crank" your child so you will both be happier! One of the best ways to turn a toddler's frown upside down is to distract them from their angry mood with silly games. Here are some to try:

SING SOME SILLY SONGS.

Instead of struggling with your little one, try singing to them. You can make up funny verses to existing songs or create your own melody and lyrics to fit the bill.

MAKE A FUNNY FACE.

A goofy grin goes a long way in stopping a tantrum in its tracks. Once you have your child's attention, ask if they have any requests: want mommy to look surprised? How about sad? Then exaggerate your expressions and watch your child go from grizzly to giggly pretty quickly.

GET PLAYFUL.

Defuse a tense moment by interjecting play into the mix for instance, if your youngster refuses to put their shoes on, tell them you are going to put them on teddy (Mommy/Daddy etc.) instead. Chances are they will cooperate as they chuckle at your jokes.

MAKE BELIEVE.

Turning a dreaded task into a flight of fantasy can make all the difference. For example, if the getting ready for formal night is a task make believe your child is a princess in a princess dress or a prince getting ready for the ball.

MEET A CHALLENGE WITH A CHALLENGE.

A contest or race may be just the thing to compel a testy child. For example, try a clean up (pick up everything that is blue, then red etc. or who can clean up faster?) To make the race official play beat the clock while your child gets ready for bed or scrambles to their buggy.

ADMIRE TALLINN, A TRUE BALTIC BEAUTY

If ever there was a beauty pageant for small medieval towns in the Baltic, Tallinn could easily take the crown—not only for its obvious good looks, but for its talent of aging ever so gracefully. Tallinn's Old Town—with its Gothic spires, ancient bell towers and winding streets—is perhaps the best preserved of its kind in all of Europe.
